It is impossible to imagine this animal with glasses. It is an allegory to the pleasure of good vision.

Jose Luis Lopez-Saura is a well-recognized painter from Segovia. Following a basically autodidactical artistic career, he has developed a unique technique based on his past experience in commercial poster design and mass communication. This artwork represents well the recent trends of this artist.

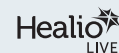
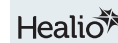
